Quilting Challenges

Throughout the year TVQG offers several quilting challenges. These challenges are intended to help increase member's quilting skills and may include making quilts to benefit local charities.

Sampler Quilt Block Exchange - Pizza Box series

The Sampler Quilt Block Exchange was announced at the September 2021 General Meeting, and it's not too late for you to join the fun. Here are the rules. This



challenge starts with you making two different quilt blocks of your choice. Bring them with you to the October 19th Meeting and place them in the pizza box that we'll provide to you. You will become the anonymous owner of that pizza box. During the meeting, pizza boxes will be passed from quilter to quilter. Each month you'll take home the pizza box and make two more different quilt blocks to add to the mix. By the conclusion of this challenge, you should have enough blocks to finish a sampler-style quilt.

Quilters are free to use any block pattern they feel comfortable making. The finished block size is 12-1/2-inches. This challenge starts in October 2021 and concluding in April 2022. If the owner of the pizza box has any special requests regarding fabric choices, colors, theme, or purpose (i.e., it's a kid's quilt), please tape any special instructions to the inside of the box lid.

UFO Challenge

We will continue the UFO challenge from last year.
Because of the disruption from COVID we will not be charging the usual \$5 to participate. For every finished UFO

(or picture) that they share during the Show and Tell segment at any General Meeting between now and October 2019, they'll earn a drawing ticket. Date for next year TBD for the drawing.

Fabric Challenge

Starting in October and concluding in March 2022 TVQG will offer the opportunity for our quilters to take participate by getting a ½ yard of fabric – Good Vibrations Pick Up Sticks from Maywood Studio and incorporate



it in a quilt to be donated to Project Linus. The quilt sizes for the blankets are Baby $36'' \times 40''$; Child $40'' \times 55''$ (or 60''); and Teen $45'' \times 65''$ (or 72'').

Project Linus is a non-profit organization that provides handmade blankets to children in need. Over 8,560,099 blankets delivered since 1995! www.projectlinus.org

The Good Neighbor Center (GNC) always needs food, personal grooming supplies, and cleaning products. Our quilters are encouraged to bring in items that GNC may need. Their urgent need right now is Large Black Trash Bags, Hand Towels and Blankets (gently used OK),

Recently we found out the Good Neighbor Center in Tigard, a charity organization TVQG has supported for many years, was in need of just about everything. The TVQG Board immediately presented a motion and approved a \$500 cash donation for them. They were ever so grateful and very excited when Michelle and Melanie dropped off the check to them. Along with the check, TVQG gifted the Good Neighbor Center cleaning items, personal grooming supplies, and 14 quilts that were made by or donated to our Charity Quilters Group.

Because TVQG is committed to assisting the Good Neighbor Center, at our upcoming guild meetings we will be bringing back the Good Neighbor Center Donation Box as a way for our members to conveniently donate products and supplies to them.

Through our website, email communications, or the TVQG Newsletter the Charity Quilters group will let members know about the Good Neighbor Center's most needed items. Their current needs are large, black trash bags, hand towels, and new or gently used blankets. However, they are always accepting of unopened shelf-stable food items, bedding, towels, personal grooming supplies, and cleaning supplies.


