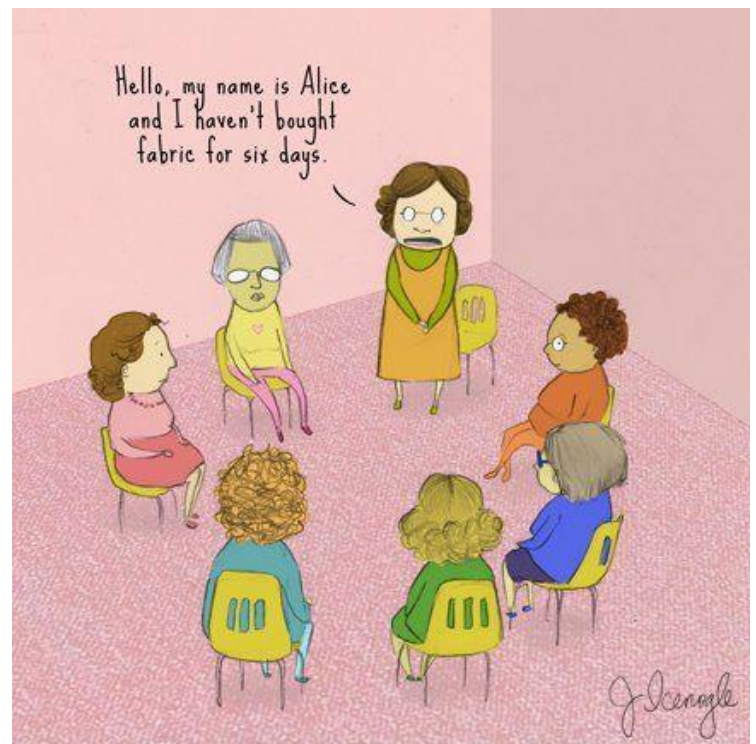

## BOM Instructions.



1/8 YARD

4 White rectangles WHITE 3" x

4 green squares 3 1/2"

4 orange squares 3 1/2"

## Block Sewing Directions

Pin and sew two green and two orange 3 1/2" squares together to form a 4-patch as shown.

Make one 4-patch unit.

Pin and sew one white 3" x 6 1/2" rectangle to each side of a 4-patch unit as shown to form block center. Press seams toward rectangles.

Pin and sew one green and one orange 3 1/2" square to either side of one white 3" x 6 1/2" rectangle as shown. Press seams toward rectangle. Make two combined
