Charity Quilts Open Sew Days

TVQG King City Clubhouse Quilters Group

Did you know that TVQG host a monthly Open Sew Days at the King City Civic Association Clubhouse located in King City, OR?

All Quilters within our community are invited to join us in the Multipurpose Room of the King City Clubhouse between 10:00am and 3:00pm on the fourth Saturday of every month. You can drop by based on your schedule, stay all day, or just for an hour or two, the choice is yours. There is no charge to attend our Monthly Open Sew Day. To make things simple there is no sign-up sheet. Just show up with your sewing machine and projects to work on. Some quilters even forgo bringing their machine and simply join their fellow quilters while doing handwork, such as binding a quilt. Irons, ironing boards, and cutting stations will be set up for your use. This is **your** Monthly Open Sew Day!

TVQG's Open Sew Days are a fantastic opportunity to interface with your fellow quilters. Lunch will be on your own, but we often join forces to bring in food for a group lunch.

Better yet, if interesting in making a Charity Quilt, free fabric, batting, and patterns are stored on-site and are available during all Open Sew Days for you to select from.

Quilting Challenges



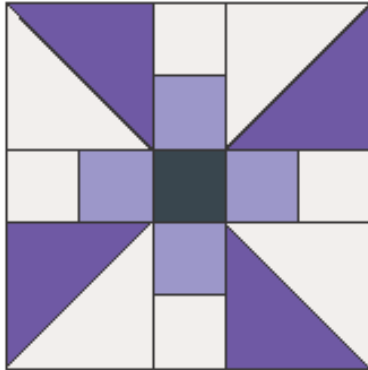

Propeller Block

SKILL LEVEL
BEGINNER

Finished Block Size
10" x 10"

Cutting Instructions (in order listed)

White dot

- 2 squares $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ "
- 1 strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12"

Purple texture

- 2 squares $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ "

Lavender dot

- 1 strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12"

Black dot

- 1 square $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

Making the Block

1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of white dot $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Place marked square on purple $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square, right sides together (**Diagram I**). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 4.



Diagram I

2 Referring to **Diagram II**, sew together white and lavender $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" strips to make strip set. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 4 segments $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

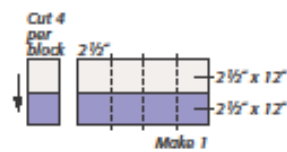


Diagram II

3 Referring to **Diagram III**, sew 3 rows using 4 pieced squares, 4 segments, and black $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew rows together to make Propeller Block.

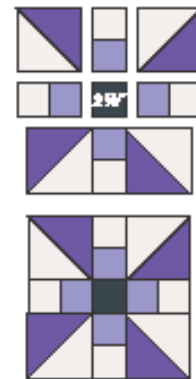
