**Brown Bag Auction**

Here’s how it works: First, go through your sewing and quilting supplies to locate items in new or good condition that you no longer need, including projects that you haven’t had the time or incentive to complete, or that scream’s “what was I thinking.” Suggested auction items to bring in could include sewing and quilting notions, fabrics, patterns, tools, or books. Then, load your auction items up and bring them with you to the September 20<sup>th</sup> meeting.

We’ll have tables set up for you to place your item(s) on. A brown paper bag will accompany each auction item. Tickets are ten for \$5.00, so that anyone at this evening’s meeting may participate by bidding on any of the items they would like to win. Even if you do not bring in an item you be able to join the fun by purchasing tickets.

Then as you browse around the room you can use your tickets to bid on items. *Hint: The more tickets you place in the brown bag by the item you’d like to win, the better your chances are of winning it.*

Cindy Calderwood will be chairing the bazaar and will need help setting up and taking down. More information about at the meeting.

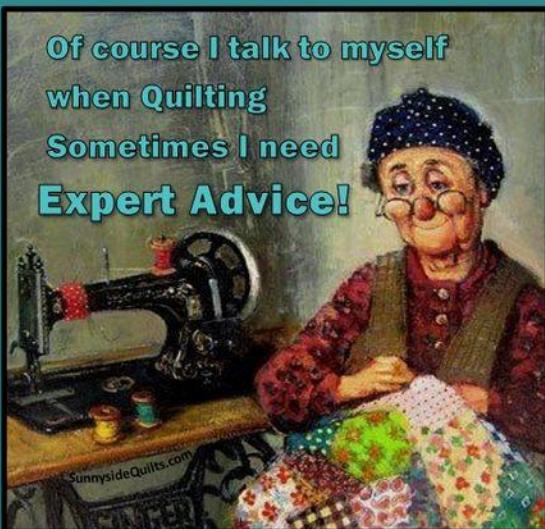
## QUILTS OF VALOR

Block of the Month August 2022

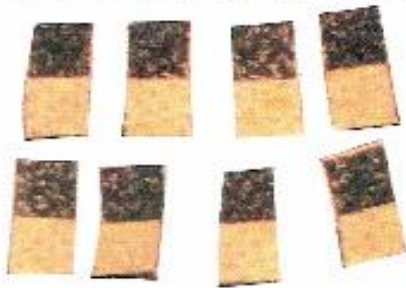
St Louis 16 Patch Block

12 1/2" unfinished

Fabric: Fall colors, orange, green, red, brown, patterns small, two colors, one lighter, one darker.

8 3.5 squares lighter fabric 8 3.5 squares darker fabric

Combine one light and one dark square to make 8.



Arrange the blocks into a checkerboard pattern with the dark fabric top left corner. Sew together to form

16 patch block.



6 patches together
