
Cindy Calderwood will be chairing the bazar and will need help setting up and taking down. More information about at the meeting.



Block of the Month August 2022


St Louis 16 Patch Block

Fabric: Fall colors, orange, green, red, brown, patterns small, two colors, one lighter, one darker.

8 3.5 squares lighter fabric 8 3.5 squares darker fabric

Combine one light and one dark square to make 8.







Arrange the blocks into a checkerboard pattern with the dark fabric top left corner. Sew together to form

16 patch block.
