

Easy Peasy

(Connecting any square block into a quilt top)

Lay out blocks in the pattern you like. ①

Number rows across the top. ②

Pin rows 1,2 and sew, 1/4", along the right side. ③

DO NOT CUT THE THREADS between the blocks.

Stack row 3 (top to last) with the first/top square block on top. ④

Repeat and continue with the rest of the rows. ⑤

Sew. Row 3. First block to row 2 first block. Second to second block, and so on. 1/4", Top, down. (Right side.)

Continue with rest of the rows the same process. ⑥

DO NOT CUT ANY THREADS!!! ⑥

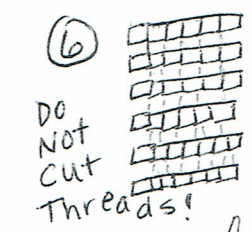
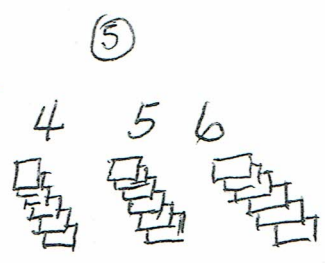
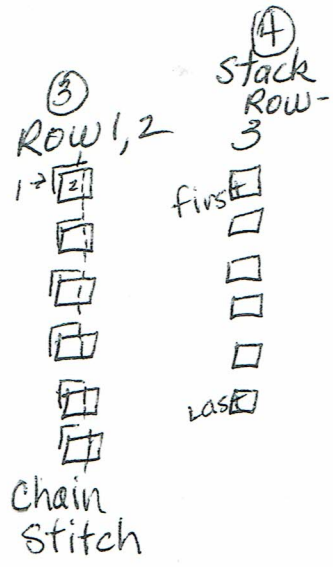
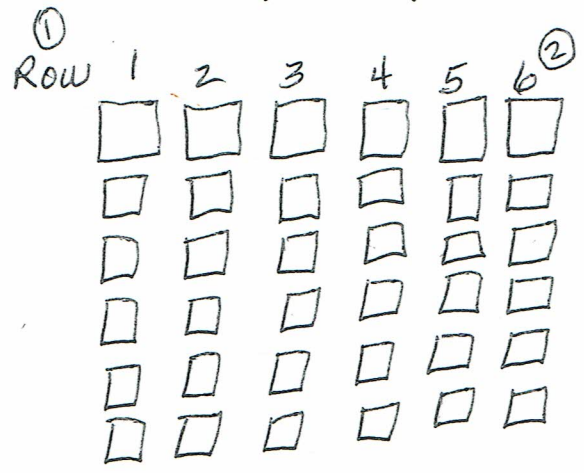
Iron all the seams open.

Match the ironed seams on the rows down. Chain Stitch across.

Iron these seams all one direction.

Voila!!

Your quilt top is done!!!!



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
