JULY BLOCK OF THE MONTH



BLOCK OF THE MONTH INSTRUCTIONS

June Block of the Month

Pinwheel Variation Quilt Block (unfinished size 10 1/2" block)


Colors - greens, yellows

Materials:

Fabric A: 2 x 4 ½" squares Fabric B: 2 x 4 ½" squares,

2 x 6* squares cut in half along the diagonal

Make 4 half square triangle units pairing the 4 ½" squares. Trim to 4" square. Sew into a 4-patch following the diagram layout. Add the 6" half square triangles onto sides of block. Trim to 10 ½".
