## Scrappy Twist on a Log Cabin

## This block features scrappy pieces of fabric set in a Log Cabin-style Block



## Fabric Requirements:

White or white tone on tone fabric:
One strip $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{\prime \prime}$ cut into
1-2.5" x 6.5" piece
$1-2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ piece
1-2.5" x 10.5" piece
1-2.5" x 12.5" piece

Medium to Dark Blue Fabric:
$1-6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$

Quilter's choice of any scrappy fabrics you have on hand. It can be any color, print, solid that you have on hand
$9-2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ different pieces

## Block Construction

1. Use 5 of the scrappy prints to make a $10.5^{\prime \prime}$ strip
2. Use 4 of the scrappy prints to make a $8.5^{\prime \prime}$ strip
3. Attach the white $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side of the blue block
4. Orientating the blue fabric to the lower-left, attach the $8.5^{\prime \prime}$ white strip to the top of the blue/white piece
5. Attach the 4-piece scrappy strip to the right side of the piece
6. Attach the 5 -piece scrappy strip to the top of the piece
7. Attach the $10.5^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right side of the piece
8. Attach the $12.5^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top of the piece

Finished Block Size = 12-inches square,
