
Scrappy Twist on a Log Cabin

This block features scrappy pieces of fabric set in a Log Cabin-style Block



Fabric Requirements:

White or white tone on tone fabric:

One strip 2.5" x 38" cut into

1 - 2.5" x 6.5" piece

1 -2.5" x 8.5" piece

1 - 2.5" x 10.5" piece

1 - 2.5" x 12.5" piece

Medium to Dark Blue Fabric:

1 - 6.5" x 6.5"

Quilter's choice of any scrappy fabrics you have on hand. It can be any color, print, solid that you have on hand

9-2.5" x 2.5" different pieces

Block Construction

- 1. Use 5 of the scrappy prints to make a 10.5" strip
- 2. Use 4 of the scrappy prints to make a 8.5" strip
- 3. Attach the white 6.5" strip to the right side of the blue block
- 4. Orientating the blue fabric to the lower-left, attach the 8.5" white strip to the top of the blue/white piece
- 5. Attach the 4-piece scrappy strip to the right side of the piece
- 6. Attach the 5-piece scrappy strip to the top of the piece
- 7. Attach the 10.5" strip to the right side of the piece
- 8. Attach the 12.5" strip to the top of the piece

Finished Block Size = 12-inches square, Unfinished Block Size 12.5-inches square
