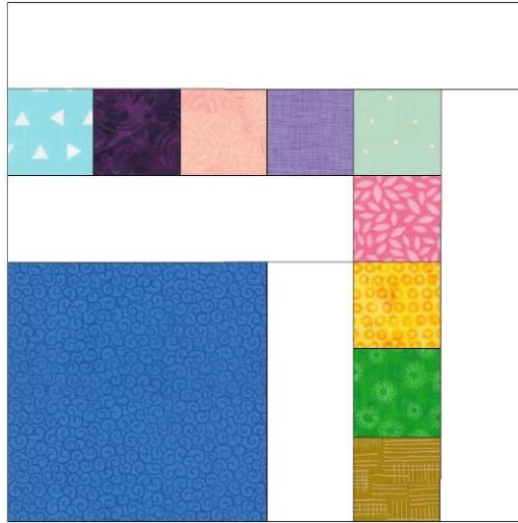


Scrappy Twist on a Log Cabin

This block features scrappy pieces of fabric set in a Log Cabin-style Block



Fabric Requirements:

White or white tone on tone fabric:

One strip 2.5" x 38" cut into

1 - 2.5" x 6.5" piece

1 - 2.5" x 8.5" piece

1 - 2.5" x 10.5" piece

1 - 2.5" x 12.5" piece

Medium to Dark Blue Fabric:

1 - 6.5" x 6.5"

Quilter's choice of any scrappy fabrics you have on hand. It can be any color, print, solid that you have on hand

9 – 2.5" x 2.5" different pieces

Block Construction

1. Use 5 of the scrappy prints to make a 10.5" strip
2. Use 4 of the scrappy prints to make a 8.5" strip
3. Attach the white 6.5" strip to the right side of the blue block
4. Orientating the blue fabric to the lower-left, attach the 8.5" white strip to the top of the blue/white piece
5. Attach the 4-piece scrappy strip to the right side of the piece
6. Attach the 5-piece scrappy strip to the top of the piece
7. Attach the 10.5" strip to the right side of the piece
8. Attach the 12.5" strip to the top of the piece

Finished Block Size = 12-inches square,
Unfinished Block Size 12.5-inches square
