Quilts of Valor was started in 2003 by Catherine Roberts.

A Quilt of Valor[®] (QOV) is a quality, handmade quilt that is machine or hand quilted. It is awarded to a Service Member or Veteran who has been touched by war. The Quilt says unequivocally, "Thank you for your service and sacrifice in serving our nation." To use the term Quilt of Valor, Quilts of Valor or QOV, the quilt must be a specific size, must have a label with required information, it must be awarded (it is not a gift) and it must be recorded.

The color profile for this block is any color solid, grunge, or any

pattern, or mini blocks (use your imagination), combined with bright white fabric for the background. The unfinished, trimmed size will be 18.5" x 20.5".

The pattern is on pages 6-7.

For every block of the month presented you will receive a ticket. If you are the lucky winner you will be awarded all the blocks submitted for the month.

Colored Cat

Original instructions: https://www.simplesimonandco.com/2016/10/halloween-mini-quilts-part.html/ Updated by Timothy Calderwood

Fabric Supplies:

- 1/2 yard of any color for the Cat. Solid, grunge, patterns, mini blocks, use your imagination!
- 1/2 yard of bright white

Cut the following.

- Cat Fabric: (1) 3" by 3" squares
- (1) 7" by 7" square
- (2) 18.5" by 6.5" rectangle

Directions:

(1) 20.5" by 6.5" rectangles (1) 14.5" by 6.5" rectangle


White Background Fabric:

(1) 2.5" by 2.5" square

(1) 3" by 3" squares

(1) 7" by 7" square

- Make 2 half square triangle (HST) from the (1) 3" by 3" squares in both cat color and white. Press seams to cat color fabric. Trim the HST's to 2.5" squares.
- Make 1 HST from the (1) 7" by 7" squares in cat color and white. Press seams to cat color fabric. Trim the HST to 6.5" square.




 Take 1 of the 18.5" by 6.5" rectangles in cat color and 1 of the white 20.5" by 6.5" rectangles and place them together at a 90-degree angle as if you were making quilt



binding. Here is what they should look like together. Stitch along the red line and press seams to cat color fabric. Trim to 20.5", removing from the white end.

4. Layout the rest of the quilt block as shown below.



5. Using the bottom of the Cat, stitch up the quilt block. Trim to 18.5" by 20.5" if needed.
