April Open Sew Day



In March, we'll reestablish the 2024 UFO Contest, following the previously submitted rules. As a reminder, here is a brief overview:

- For every UFO completed in 2024 you will receive a drawing ticket.
- Because we are getting a late start on the 2024 Drawing, it will be OK to backtrack to the beginning of 2024.
- There is no charge to participate.
- The 2024 UFO prizes will be awarded at the January 2025 General Meeting.
- Ticket submissions will be on the honor system no documentation is needed.
- It is the member's responsibility to enter their name/ticket into the 2024 UFO jar.
- As of March, the 2024 UFO jar will be displayed at every meeting on the membership table
- To avoid misplacing the jar, it will be retained and stored in the onsite lockers making sure the jar is always available.
- Three cash prizes of \$20 each will be awarded. If you have any questions regarding our 2024 UFO Challenge, please ask them at any meeting.

Hopewell House is an end-of-life care facility. When a new client is admitted to Hopewell House they are allowed to pick a comfort quilt to use while they are in the care of the facility. Then after their passing their quilt is shared as a remembrance with their family.

It is a true honor for TVQG to share quilts for this cause, and we are thankful to play a small part in bringing comfort to someone approaching their final days.
